You will assist with all the activities of daily living including personal, social, physical, recreational, vocational, and educational needs. You will utilize your robust knowledge of theory, principles, and practices in the care of persons with diverse abilities and your positive and friendly attitude to support him in helping him to achieve his life goals.

Primary Responsibilities:

- · Facilitate community plan for client, including physical, recreational, and educational activities
- Assist in daily tasks to allow for maximum independence
- Assist with personal care (including showering, shaving, teeth brushing and partial help with dressing)
- Schedule, accompany and facilitate appointments
- Help manage budget and spending decisions

- Monitor and facilitate neurological deficits and physical disabilities
