Uses electric and pneumatic tools such as Skill Saw, Band Saw, Grinders, Sanders, and Reciprocating Saw Sets up equipment and performs MIG and TIG welding of aluminum boats (hulls, bottoms, parts) according to drawings and specifications

Sands and grinds boats as needed

Moves boats and/or parts to carts with overhead hoist system

Completes required documentation of welded boats for production purposes

Works with the team and other departments to ensure quality and follows documented work instructions
